Imaginative Worlds - \$35

Children will brainstorm their own 'imaginative world' and create a grid system painting, modelled on Esther's own style. A unique opportunity to work with this talented young artist that should not be missed! Age 6 to 12

Flying High - \$35

This class will turn your child's life upside down in the most exhilarating way! Children will be introduced to aerial hammocks and aerial artistry. SPARK is teaming up with Studio Samsara to provide the opportunity to learn fun tricks and poses that will showcase their determination and strength. 'Animals of Oz'

Animals Galore! - \$35

Does your child love animals? The Animals of Oz 'Animals Galore' program involves a range of native animals and reptiles. Children will learn about the animals, their environment and conservation, and will also get the opportunity to interact with them. Yes, they get to touch the animals! This hands on session will also give children the opportunity to create their own habitat boxes based on one of the animals they have seen. Age 6 to 12

Wednesday 12 April

Robotics: Introductory - \$35

In this session children will be provided with a basic insight into Robotics using 'Dash' and iPad technology. They will learn about the function of a robot brick, motors and sensors. They will build a base chassis made from Lego and learn how to program the robots to perform basic functions using the NXT Brick software program. Children will not be able to take the robots home after the session, but parents are free to record a video of the child's robot creation in action at the end of the lesson. Age 8 to 12

Musical Theatre - \$35

This session will allow children to be a star of the stage! They will learn about all the elements of performing on stage including singing, dancing and acting. Children will learn a song and dance routine from a famous musical, ready to perform to their adoring audience of parents and carers! Age 6 to 12

RoboCup Competition

Workshop - \$35

In this session children will build a robot to design specification and program the robot to complete various challenges outlined in the RoboCup Rescue Competition. These challenges include line following and learning how to activate the touch and ultrasonic sensors. Children will not be able to take the robots home after the session, but parents are free to record a video of the child's robot creation in action at the end of the lesson. Age 8 to 12

Dance Sampler - \$35

This class provides a taste of jazz, tap and classical dance. Children will learn the basics of these styles of dance and have fun trying different ways of moving to music. All that is needed is enthusiasm and energy. No previous dance skills required! Age 6 to 12
